

Overview of anti-virus protection at Texas Tech University

Details

The TTU IT Division licenses and provides two anti-malware solutions—[Microsoft Defender for Endpoint \(MSDfE\)](#) and [Symantec Endpoint Protection \(SEP\)](#)—free of charge to TTU faculty, staff, and students.

MSDfE is intended for use on TTU-owned Macs and PCs, while SEP should be installed on personally-owned Macs and PCs.

MSDfE

MSDfE can be installed on TTU-owned computers by your college or department's primary support provider using KACE or a GPO.

The current SEP version at TTU is 14.3 RU1.

 **NOTE:** Some SEP versions do not have a separate 64-bit version. If you do not have an option between a 64-bit version and a 32-bit version, the installation package will detect whether your operating system is 32-bit or 64-bit, and the correct version of SEP will be installed automatically.
